

MK1/2, MK2/2, and MK2/3 Scroll Outlines (approx. size)

1" mark



How to determine scroll sizes:

1. Consult the drawing to establish the size of scroll you wish to make.
2. Select the appropriate measurement as indicated on the scroll outline.
3. Mark off the measurement you have selected onto the edge of the material to be formed.
4. Place the metal into the Scroll Bender and form metal around the scroll segments until the marked edge meets at a tangent with the scroll segment.
5. Sizes shown can only be approx. due to the "spring back" of the metal used.
6. To ensure uniformity on repeat scrolls, metal should be started at the same point for each scroll made.
7. To assist with repeat scrolls, triangular magnetic markers (included with scroll benders) can be placed on the scroll segments and used to indicate the stopping point.

MK2/2 Scroll Bender:

Scroll formed using 3/4" x 1/8" flat strip metal.
Approx. overall scroll diameter 5".
Approx. total material used 17 1/2".

MK1/2 Scroll Bender:

Scroll formed using 1/2" x 3/32" flat strip metal.
Approx. overall scroll diameter 3".
Approx. total material used 8 1/4".

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MK2/3 Scroll Bender:

Scroll formed using 3/4" x 1/8" flat strip metal.
Approx. overall scroll diameter 4 3/8".
Approx. total material used 14 1/2".
